

## Albemarle County Electoral Board

Minutes: January 10, 2018

Location: Albemarle County Office Building, McIntire Road

Attendance: Jim Heilman, Bill Love, Peter Wurzer, Jake Washburne, Clarice Schermerhorn

The meeting began at 9:33 am.

The minutes for December 15, 2017, were amended and then unanimously approved.

Precinct and Polling Place Changes. Peter has put together a "skeleton" summary analysis of the changes proposed and why we are proposing them – to be used in discussion with the Board of Supervisors at their February 7 work session.

There was a discussion of the deadline(s) for getting these changes completed. Late April or early May is our deadline for doing everything that needs to be done for most of them. Therefore, the Board agreed that the end of March should be the optimum deadline for obtaining Board of Supervisors approval. It was noted that the only change that absolutely must happen by then is the folding of Belfield precinct back in to the Jack Jouett precinct as that change must happen before the June primary.

The moving of University Hall polling place to Slaughter Recreation Center needs to have an effective date of August or September as that change cannot happen before the June primary.


There was a discussion of the proper polling place for the new Biscuit Run precinct (cut out of the Cale precinct). Bill proposed recommending Monticello High School as the polling place. The motion passed unanimously.

The precinct lines for the two existing precincts in the Crozet/Brownsville area (which are now being altered by the creation of a third – Mechums River – precinct) were discussed. Jake proposed a minor modification of our proposed lines between the Brownsville and Crozet precincts. Consensus was to accept his modification pending a statistical analysis of the number of voters who would be affected.

Several minor modifications were made to Peter's summary analysis mentioned above.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:25 am.
