The Board and staff convened at the meeting and public hearing of the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors (BoS) at 6 pm.


The purpose of the public hearing was to receive comments and questions from the public on proposed changes to Albemarle County precincts and polling places. Electoral Board members answered a few questions from the BoS. No members of the public spoke.

After the public hearing was closed, the BoS voted unanimously to:

- (1) Create a new precinct out of part of the existing Cale precinct, name it "Biscuit Run", and establish its polling place as Monticello High School;
- (2) Create a new precinct out of part of the existing Free Bridge precinct, name it "Pantops", and establish its polling place as Broadus Memorial Baptist Church;
- (3) Create a new precinct out of part of the existing Brownsville and Crozet precincts, name it "Mechums River", and establish its polling place as Western Albemarle High School; and
- (4) Deactivate the current Belfield precinct and move its voters into the Jack Jouett precinct.

The ordinance passed is attached to the minutes.
