Attendance: Jim Heilman, Bill Love, Peter Wurzer, Jake Washburne, Clarice Schermerhorn, Lauren Eddy


Guests: (At various times) Democratic Party Representatives Michael Rodemeyer or Abigail Turner; Republican Party Representative Cynthia Burkett

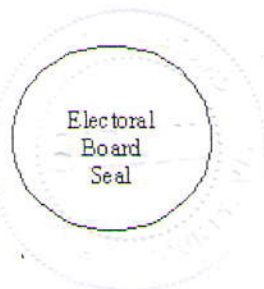

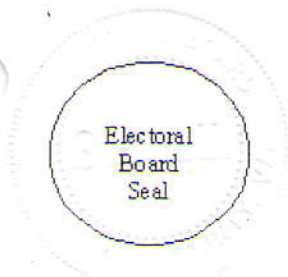

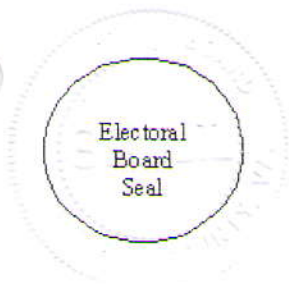
