Minutes: May 17, 2018

The meeting began at 1:02 pm.

The minutes for March 14, April 4, and May 2 were approved unanimously.

Ensuring that Registrants are in Proper Precincts. In light of (1) our creation of 3 new precincts and (2) the discovery that several localities elsewhere in the State have found voters registered in the wrong precinct, Jake announced that Tex Weaver in the County GIS unit can do an overlay of all 3,744 street segments in the County with local and state district lines to determine if any of our voters are registered in the wrong place.


Contract with PrintElect for Ballot Printing. Jake announced that the County Purchasing Agent reviewed the contract we have agreed to and found a couple minor issues. He will review those with PrintElect. Peter suggested that Jake also discuss the matter with the County Attorney.

June 12 Republican Senatorial Primary.

- We discussed and made changes to the training agenda for Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs.
- We discussed voter outreach concerning our new precincts.
- We decided that officials in our Central Absentee Precinct do not need to convene until 11 am (and possibly 12 noon if absentee voting continues to be low) on Primary Day.
- It was determined that Logic and Accuracy Testing for the machines will be conducted by our staff on May 24th.
- Parking issues at the University Hall Polling Place were discussed. Clarice will contact the head of UVA Parking and Transportation as to what we are planning to do in that regard on Primary Day.
