Albemarle County Police have made an arrest in the investigation of vehicle vandalism and thefts from parked vehicles.

Albemarle County Police Officers arrested Ricky Allen Corbin Jr., a 20 year old white male resident of Pughs Store Road in Afton, Va. He has been charged with one felony count of attempted grand larceny, one misdemeanor count of tampering with a vehicle and one misdemeanor count of possession of marijuana.

Ricky Allen Corbin Jr. was arrested Friday afternoon at approximately 12:00 p.m. (9-04-2009) as police caught him attempting to steal items from a parked vehicle located in the 2500 block of Ridge Road. Corbin Jr. has been linked to a number of other vehicle break-ins throughout Albemarle County. This is an ongoing investigation and additional charges against Corbin are possible.

Corbin Jr. has been released on bond pending his trial date.
