

Election Officials Needed in Albemarle County

The pay is not overwhelming; the service to your community is great!

Registered voters in Albemarle County are needed to serve as Officers of Election in the polling places on Election Day. This community service requires good reading, writing, and public relations skills. It also requires the strength to assist with polling place set-up and the stamina to endure a long day. Training is provided.

The hours of service are from 5:15 a.m. until the polls are closed and the statement of results is completed, usually around 8:30 p.m. Officers of Election are paid \$155.00 for working Election Day and an additional \$10.00 for attending a two-hour training session.

Each Election Officer must be:

- ✓ a competent person, fully capable of performing required duties in a mature and pleasant manner.
- ✓ of good moral character
- ✓ a qualified voter of Albemarle County, and
- ✓ agree to represent either the Republican or Democratic Party (party membership not required).

An Election Official must not:

- ✓ hold any elective office, or
- ✓ be the deputy or employee of an elected official

If you feel you are qualified and are interested in serving, please complete the following information, fold, stamp, and mail this form to the address on the back, or deliver to the Electoral Board Office in Room 131 of the Albemarle County Office Building at 401 McIntire Road, phone 434-296-5863. Election Official appointments are made by the Albemarle County Electoral Board, which is the sole judge of qualification and eligibility.
