Background

- February 17, 2021: Albemarle Board of Supervisors (BOS) directed staff to pursue the development of a solid waste convenience center, located on a County-owned parcel in Keene
- March 17, 2021: BOS appropriated \$1.1 million to fund the design and construction of the facility, including all containers and compactors necessary to open the operation
- Design initiated by RSWA and Draper Aden
- Comprehensive Plan Compliance Review in October

A Convenience Center is a Place To Take...

- Bagged Household Waste
- Compostable Food Waste
- •Recyclables, including:
 - Glass
 - Plastics
 - Paper and Cardboard
 - Tin and Other Metals

•Special Waste Streams (hazardous waste, e-waste) may be offered it he future

•Fully staffed during operating hours



Tag-A-Bag Household Trash

- Compacted and removed daily
- "Cost Convenient"
 - Dropped at Convenience Center: \$2.00 per 32-gallon bag
 - Average local hauler \$29/month for curbside
 - Tags will be available from local merchants or for purchase by mail




MSW Self-Contained Compactor

- Door on feed shoot generally limits waste to trash bag sizes.
- Won't accept commercial, construction waste



Hours of Operation

- Service Days: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday
- Operations closed on Thursday to facilitate emptying site containers, site cleaning and maintenance
- Service Hours: seasonally set (such as winter hours of 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM; 8:30 AM to 6:30 PM during summer months)



Community Benefits


- Convenience centers proven to reduce illegal dumping

- Curbs open burning


Where Will It Be Located?

Occasional Users (10-mile radius)


Frequent Users (7.5-mile radius)

What Will It Look Like? Conceptual design






Traffic Plan
