- 1. Abigail joined as a potential new NHC member- round of introductions
- Update on conservation moving at Darden Towe Park
 - interest in planting a strip of natives in the conservation mowing area between the soccer field and tennis courts.
 - PMG has ordered buttonbush from the Department of Forestry for a celebratory planting in DT
 - Emma has resized Conservation Mowing signs to be enlarged as a yard sign in Spanish on one side and English on the other.
 - 6th graders from Peabody School wrote to ACPR in support of the Piedmont grassland habitat at DT and want to be involved in creating more of it.
- 3. The Downtown and Gordon Ave JMRL branches received pollinator grant- Christine reached out and is waiting to meet with both branch managers
- 4. Christine reported on the meeting with Nicola McGoff (Wild Ginger Services) about efforts to plant natives in and around the town of Scottsville. Nicola also provided advice about DT meadow restoration.
- 5. Michael is working on a native wildflower stamp project in conjunction with the PMG speaker program with the possibility to share resources with the County
