Rio Corridor Plan Update:

- 1. David Benish presented information on Phase I draft.
 - a. 20 page document with maps to post online around January 31, online comments accepted.
 - b. Asked all CAC members to review and submit comments by next CAC meeting
- 2. Danial Hyer presented information on Phase II of study which covers E. Rio Rd from John W. Warner Parkway to the city limits.
 - a. Recapped the background, accident data, pending changes in the area covered
 - b. Phase II divided into 3 sections, North, Central and South.
 - c. Focus on North section during this meeting due to traffic
 - d. Will cover Central and South sections over next 2 meetings.
 - e. Baseline traffic volumes presented were based on 2019 data
 - f. Provided estimates of increased traffic volumes of planned development
 - g. Listed new developments where estimated traffic volumes not yet computed
 - h. Accident data showed, noted there were no fatal accidents.

- i. Presented two options of controlling traffic and explained benefits
- j. Opened meeting up for question and/or comments

- 1. Meeting with VDOT, covered traffic lights for new developments, Rio Pt main entrance, Hillsdale/Greenbrier intersection traffic study, added stop signs on Brentwood Rd in Woodbrook
