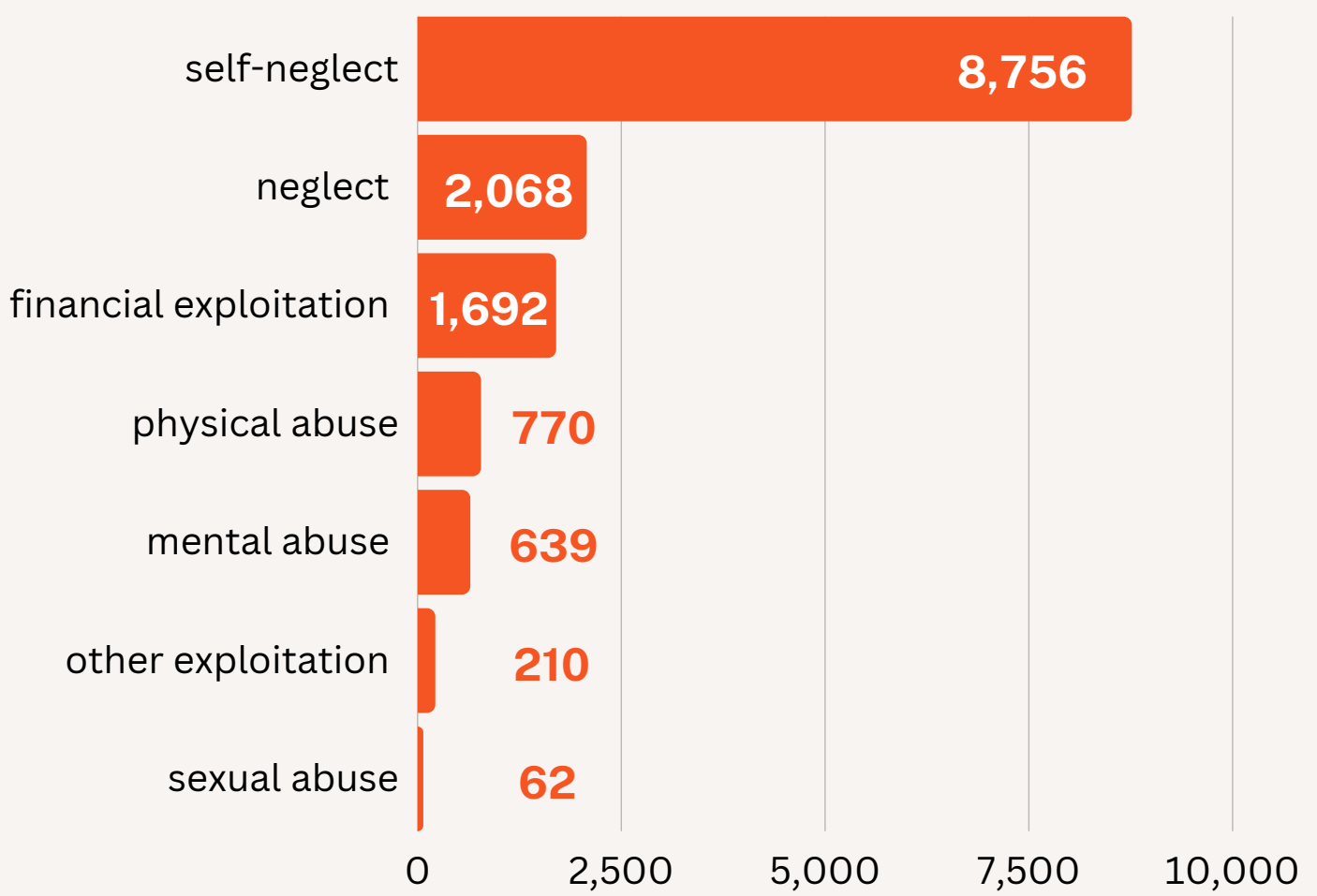

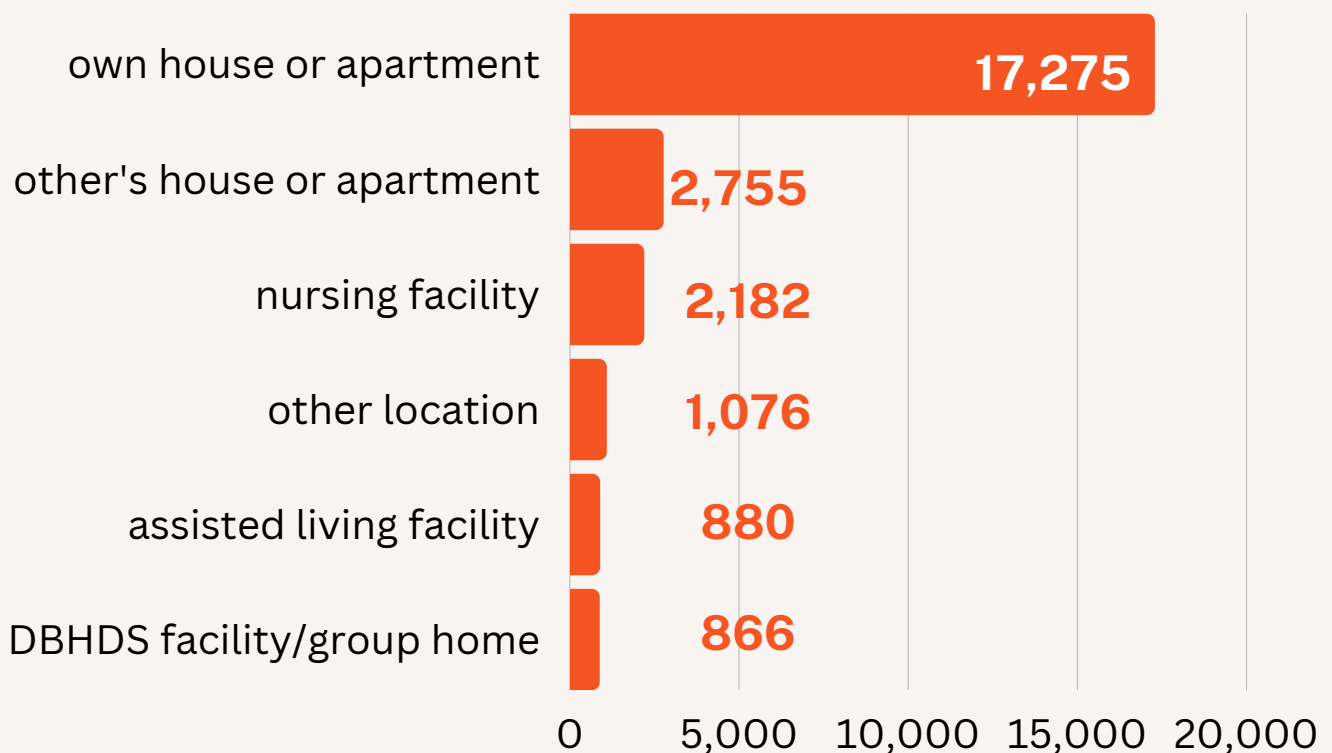

### TYPES OF ABUSE IN SUBSTANTIATED REPORTS



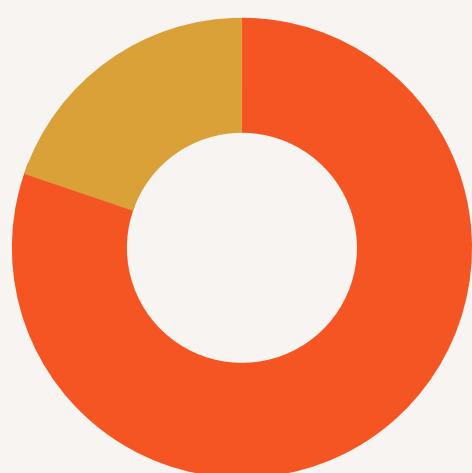
### LOCATION OF INCIDENT



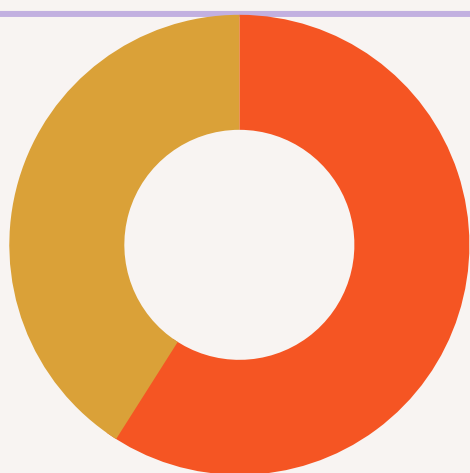
