Mr. Henry **seconded** the motion.

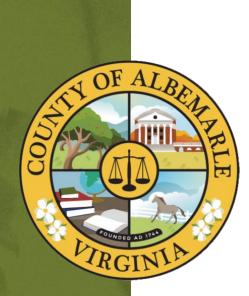
