- Solar Ordinance Feedback
 - Discussion about the feedback. Summary of important points to be made:
 - vegetative management plan
 - o limit mass grading and stump removal at all cost
 - o decompaction of soils after construction and after decommission
 - o increase in stream buffers to 300 ft
 - o independent 3rd party reviews and inspectors
 - o more focus on community solar
- Wildlife Corridors
 - Leah went out with researcher and will put information on Wildlife Corridor Hub
 - Plan to apply for funding for a wildlife corridor in the Afton/64 area getting lots of data to support this
 - Two of the bobcats being tracked were killed by cars
- Budget update for invasive plant management- Christine promised to share her letter to the BoS and encouraged NHC members to individually share their concerns about the absence of funding in the FY25 budget.
- o Biophilic Region Update
 - Work group meeting with key people and gathering information
 - Looking at the biophilic application
 - Mona would like to work with her students on this
 - Kaleb wants to work on this
